The aim of EFEB Network is the development of strong partnership working in the field of educational development, training and support activities in the area of female entrepreneurship, relating especially to social entrepreneurship, eco-innovation and digital economy.

3. Organization and implementation of 18 EFEB Academies in each country with a total of 900 participants
